General Manager's Report



Our first ever large food aid shipment left for Haiti on May 27th! This is something to celebrate as it feels like the final piece of our mission's puzzle. Everything from dreaming the concept of Niagara Christian Gleaners (NCG), raising the funds, building and equipping a brand new food plant,

culminating in this first food aid shipment. Eight pallets of more than 30,000 servings each were included on a container headed for Haiti. We're working with a Christian organization called Speroway (speroway.com) who have been doing long standing relief work in many countries including Haiti. We began conversation with this organization more than 8 months ago and it's a joy to partner with them on







this initial, significant, milestone shipment. Much of this food aid will support school nutrition programs that they are a part

of in and around the city of Pignon, Haiti. Praise God for amazing progress at NCG!

Our ability to respond and actually meet this need in short order (formal request came just 2 weeks before) has much to do with our packaging line. Every day we package the previous days' dryer load(s) and then work through our barreled inventory. Eventually all of our dried produce will be packaged almost immediately and be available to meet requests as they come to us. This is particularly helpful when we may get urgent requests to meet crisis need. Our goal is to inventory minimally and ship the prepared food out more readily.





We've been equally blessed by a committed community of volunteers who come out every day to lend a hand. Many have added NCG into their weekly routine and I often find volunteers who have pegged their preferred part in this amazing mission. It could be a regular day (or days) they come or a task that they particularly enjoy doing. I'm also not surprised by the very DNA of our volunteers. They are a

giving bunch who know the joy in serving. Often if I miss them it's because of their involvement in another worthy mission which clearly displays the hearts of service in the volunteers we are attracting. We desire this volunteer pool to grow and include as many as possible so that the saying in our warehouse is expanded: "You will be blessed when you come in



and blessed when you go out." Deuteronomy 28:6. If you are one of those individuals who have been wondering about getting involved with NCG - please come and spend some time with us. We love meeting new people and sharing our passion of righting a wrong in the area of food waste, building an amazing community of volunteers and meeting need in a hungry, hurting world. All for the glory of God!


Board Report

May 27 marked the day that our first major food shipment left our doors bound for Haiti (see GM report). We thank God for this opportunity to provide. We are also thankful for the support shown for this ministry at our Gratitude dinners. It was a joy, as board members, to meet many of you at this celebration of the Lord's goodness and provision. The support shown by our volunteers and the gifts received from our donors provide the means to fulfill our mission of providing food to those in need. Please continue to support us in reaching our budgetary needs for this year.

The board has approved the purchase of a spare dicer as a backup to ensure that our food production continues every day. Plans are also in place to expand the parking lot, so don't let finding a parking spot keep you from volunteering! Our third need, brought up at our dinners, was for another produce cooler. This has been met with a 53 foot long reefer trailer that has been provided for our use.

Continue to also pray not only for our task here in Smithville, but also now for the ministries that distribute the food and the people who will benefit from this nutrition. May it be part of our prayer when we pray, "Thy kingdom come, thy will be done...".
